The "Consorzio per la Tutela dell'Asti" (Consortium for the Protection of Asti wines) was officially founded on 17th December 1932. The consortium aims to promote and protect Asti Sparkling and Moscato d'Asti Docg wines in Italy and worldwide. The consortium's role also includes quality control along the entire production chain and monitoring the use of the designation name to prevent counterfeiting. Its Research Laboratory promotes and coordinates specific scientific studies and innovative technologies to continuously improve the production. The consortium coordinates and promotes activities to enhance the area of origin of Moscato Bianco grapes, whose cultivation covers 9,700 hectares in 51 municipalities of the provinces of Alessandria, Asti, and Cuneo. Asti Spumante is also of one of the five Core Zones of the vineyard landscapes of Langhe-Roero and Monferrato, a UNESCO World Heritage site. Asti and Moscato d'Asti can be considered the two Italian white sweet wines *par excellence* and rank among the great wines of Piedmont.
